Olympic Qualification System - Continental Championships Calendar - Track

Dear President,

As you are aware, on the forthcoming 6 and 7 February, the IOC Executive Committee will ratify the Qualification Systems of all sports for the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games.

On the last page of each document are listed the several milestones between now and the Olympic Games.

In accordance with the Qualification System Principles developed by the IOC, the qualification period cannot begin sooner than two years prior to the final entries deadline set on 6 July 2020.

Since the 2020 UCI Track Cycling World Championships presented by Tissot in Berlin have been designated to be the last qualifying event, this implies that all qualifying events must take place between 6 July 2018 until 23 February 2020.

Consequently, the two editions of your Continental Championships that will count towards the UCI Olympic Track Ranking 2018-2020 will have to take place within this 20 months period.

To inform all National Federations in a timely manner, we would need to identify both editions, dates and locations, for each of the five continents in the nearest possible future.

We look forward to receiving from you the calendar of the Elite Continental Championships pertaining to your respective continent, even if only provisional at this stage.
