


(1) Map of Race Area

V. Specific Regulations

PARAGRAPH 1. 2010 Asian MTB Championships

The 16th 2010 Asian MTB Championships & 2nd Asian Junior Mountain Bike Championships (2010 Asian MTB Championships) is one of the international races, which are registered in the Asian Cycling Calendar of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI). This event is a Continental Championship registered on the 2010 UCI Mountain Bike Calendar.

The 2010 Asian MTB Championships is organized by Asian Cycling Confederation and is superintended by 2010 Asian MTB/BMX Championships Organizing Committee, Korea Cycling Federation and Jecheon City. It is held under the regulations of International Cycle Union (UCI) and the Korea Cycling Federation (KCF).

PARAGRAPH 2. Participation

Only riders who observe the UCI articles as well as the regulations as well as the ACC regulations have the right to participate in the 2010 Asian MTB Championships. These riders must have valid licenses issued by the federations affiliated to the UCI.

PARAGRAPH 2. Category of Event

The 2010 Asian MTB Championships is a continental championship and the categories are as follows:

- Cross-Country (XCO): Elite Men, Elite Women, Junior Men, and Junior Women
- Downhill (DHI): Elite Men and Elite Women.

Points are awarded in conformity with the UCI rules

PARAGRAPH 3. Insurance

All participants must be adequately insured against accidents & civil responsibility insurance before they leave their country.

The organizer will not compensate for any accidents and injuries that may occur during one's stay in Korea.

PARAGRAPH 4. ID Card and Access Restriction

All persons taking part in the 2010 Asian MTB Championships must carry their ID cards in order to identify themselves and to be admitted into controlled places, such as the areas around the starting and finish lines and the Headquarters. ID cards will be handed out upon checking in to the official hotel.

PARAGRAPH 5. Transfer between the hotel and the venue

Shuttles will be provided for teams to transfer between the hotel and the venue.

PARAGRAPH 6. Transfer to the downhill start area

Riders and officials may take the monorail in order to get to the downhill start area

PARAGRAPH 7. First Aids Measures

The headquarter will provide first aid on the scene during the event. Participants will be responsible for any further treatment after the Championships.

PARAGRAPH 9. Time Keeping

Photo-finish, light beams and transponders will be used to produce results.

PARAGRAPH 10. Anti-doping Control

The UCI and KADA anti-doping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

Moreover, in conformity with the law of Korea, the Korean anti-doping legislation is applicable in addition to the UCI anti-doping regulations.

The anti-doping tests will take place at the facility near the finish line.

PARAGRAPH 11. Green Sport

Cycling is a green sport.

All personnel are reminded that the race passes through areas of wildlife and natural bea uty, historical sites and reserves that .we should help to preserve.

Neither littering nor throwing water bottles along the race course is strictly prohibited.
