INTRODUCTION

This document contains the information needed by all participating Asian National Federations for The 8th Asian BMX Championships & Asian Junior BMX Championships 2013, to be held in Singapore from 17th May to 19th May 2013.

1. Rules

The 8th Asian BMX Championships & Asian Junior BMX Championships 2013 will be conducted in accordance with the latest Rules and Regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI) and the Asian Cycling Confederation (ACC). In case of disagreement in the translation of the rules, the English text shall prevail. Any general issues will be resolved in accordance with the UCI and ACC Constitution. Only the UCI scale of penalty shall be applicable

a. Rules change & implementations Art. 6.1.056

According to article 1.3.059 every rider competing in a BMX world championship (Championship, Challenge and Masters level) and at the continental championships (Championship level) must wear a national BMX jersey matching the jerseys of his fellow-countrymen. The only variation allowed shall be advertising on the jersey. The national jersey must be worn whenever a rider is engaged in activities on the track, prize giving ceremonies, press conferences, television interviews, autograph sessions and other occasions during the event, which require a good presentation to the media and the outside world.

This article can be found in the new BMX rulebook and additionally, all Federations and confederations have specifically been informed about this during a mail concerning the Off-Road disciplines on 6th February 2013. They had to pass on this information to their riders.

If junior and elite riders are not wearing their national team clothing, the penalty rules apply in part 1 of the general regulations.

Art. 1.3.072

Rider not wearing:

- world champion's jersey: team: 2,500 to 5,000 and start of the rider concerned not permitted
- leader's jersey of a UCI cup, circuit, series or classification:
- team: 2,500 to 5,000 and start of the rider concerned not permitted
- rider: start not permitted and loss of 50 points in the UCI classification concerned
- national champion's jersey: team: 2,500 to 5,000
- national clothing: team: 500 to 1,000 per rider and start of the riders concerned not permitted

The penalty for not wearing national team clothing is 500-1000 CHF and the interdiction to start the competition.

We can give a derogation because it's the first year that this rule applies for BMX and let the riders start the competition. But they will need to pay a penalty that we could reduce to 100 CHF.

From 2014, rule 1.3.072 will strictly be followed and riders / federations not following the rules, will not be able to compete at the CC.





2. Participation

As per UCI Regulations 10.1.005, all National Federations affiliated to Asian Cycling Confederation can take part in The 8th Asian BMX Championships & Asian Junior BMX Championships 2013.


Extract from UCI regulations (chapter x. continental championships)

- 10.1.005 All National Federations affiliated to their Continental Association and only these, can take part in Continental Championships races. The maximum number of riders taking part in the various races will be the same for all these Federations.
- 10.1.006 A rider against whom an investigation was opened in relation to affect which may cause a breach of UCI Anti Doping Rules, will not be eligible for the Continental Championships and is not authorized to participate to the Continental Championships until the end of suspension or until his definitive acquittal. In the event of a positive 'A' sample, this clause applies starting from the notification of the abnormal analysis result to the rider. Unless otherwise decided by the anti doping commission, the above paragraph is also applicable in the event of an investigation or a procedure regarding such fact, opened in pursuance of a law or other regulation. Specific cases are examined by the anti doping commission or its president. Their decision is without appeal.
- In addition to the disqualification, the licensee and his or her National Federation will be respectively sanctioned by a fine of CHF 2000 to CHF 10000. The present condition for participation, aims to protect the integrity, serenity and reputation of the Championships. Its application does not prejudge the decision whether an anti doping violation has occurred and shall not give right to any claim in the events of acquittal.


Track Layout



9. Official Ceremony

In accordance with the order set in the programmed published by the organizer, The Asian Champion, the second and the third placed riders shall be ready for the official ceremony that shall be conducted under the responsibility of the Chief Commissaire (PCP).

The following arrangement shall be apply to the official ceremonies. Within 10 minutes following the end of each race (unless otherwise provided and duly recorded in an official communiqué), the Asian Champions, the second and the third placed riders shall be ready for the official ceremony that shall be conducted under the responsibility of the Chief Commissaire (PCP). Any infringement of the provisions of article 9.1.044 to 9.1.050 above shall be fine of CHF 2,000 to CHF 10,000. A higher fine may be imposed depending on the advantage derived from the offence.

NOTE: Federations are required to bring 2 pieces of National Flag measured 1.x2m (3 feet x 6 feet) and a National anthem CD handover to the organizer upon their arrival.

10. Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control will be carried out during the Asian BMX Championship under the UCI Anti-Doping Regulations. Location of the Anti-Doping station will be on-site at the BMX track.

11. Location & Name of International Airport

Singapore Changi Airport is located on the eastern most end of the island of Singapore. It is about 20 minutes drive to the city area and business district.

12. Location & Name of Race Hotel

The Official Race Hotel is *Changi Village Hotel* and it's within 15 min of travel to both the airport and the race venue.
