2010-2011 UCI BMX Calendar

Dear Sir, Dear Madam,

In order to successfully complete the **2010- 2011 UCI BMX Calendar**, we would like to ask you to fill out electronically and send back the attached official UCI registration form **through email** to register all your events before the **28**th **February 2010**.

Note the detailed procedures and information below in order to register events;

1. Procedure to follow

- a) The National Federation sends to the Organiser a blank PDF, available at: http://oldsite.uci.ch/calendar.htm
- b) The Organiser fills out electronically the PDF file and sends it back by email to the National Federation for approval.
- c) The National Federation checks the content of the PDF file, approves it electronically directly in the PDF file and sends it to Johan Lindstrom, by email.

2. UCI Calendar registration deadline and modification

Federations not respecting the deadline of **28th February 2010** may be fined, and also for modification or cancellation of Calendar events done after this deadline.

Every request of modification or cancellation with authorization should be officially announced to the UCI minimum 30 days prior to the event;

An administration fee will be charged for each request: 185.- €

In case of request of modification officially announced to the UCI less than 30 days prior to the event, the UCI will consider this modification without authorization;

A fine will be charged for each request: 400.- €

In case of request of cancellation officially announced to the UCI less than 30 days prior to the event, the UCI will consider this cancellation without authorization:

The UCI Calendar fee will remain due in full, no refund.

The taxes vary between continents. See financial obligation attached.

3. Type of race

As you are already aware of, since the 1st of August 2009, a new UCI ranking and calendar structure has been introduced.

The UCI Calendar presents 6 different classes:

Class 0 event: Olympic Games
Class 1 event: World Championships

Class 2 event: World Cup

Class 2TT event: Time Trials World Cup

Class 3 event: Continental Championships (1 per continent)

Class 4 event: International "Classics" Competitions (maximum 4 per continent)
Class 5 event: International Competitions (unlimited number per continent)

Class 6 event: National Championships

All competitions open for foreign riders and with more than 50 foreign riders are considered an international event and must be register on the International Calendar.

As previous years, the Continental Championships and National Championships must be scheduled on a pre scheduled date (per continent) decided by each continent's confederation.

The 2011 UCI BMX Supercross World Cup is subject to a bidding procedure. National Federations and/or organizers are asked to contact UCI directly to receive the related information regarding the procedure besides the registration form.

The ranking points granted for the different class types are visible on the UCI Regulation/BMX/p.39 attached.

4. 2010-2011 UCI BMX Pre-calendar

Enclosed is also the 2010-2011 UCI BMX Pre-calendar, functioning as a guideline on which dates events are allowed to be entered.

5. Calendar Fee

As in previous season, the UCI is adopting the same fees for the 2010/2011 BMX Calendar. The fees vary depending on which continent (as other UCI disciplines). Furthermore, as it relates to the calendar fees for the <u>class 3 and 4 events</u>, the UCI will appoint and pay for the Chief Commissaire, as mentioned in the appointment table attached. For the detailed calendar fees, please see the UCI Financial Obligations (<u>www.uci.ch</u> / Publications / Financial Obligations / BMX) which you can also find attached as mentioned before.
